Committee Report/Decisions

Eco Mark Committee for Establishing Category and Criteria (33rd meeting)

The 33rd Eco Mark Committee for Establishing Category and Criteria (EMCECC, Chairman: Prof. Takashi Gunjima, Doshisha Univ.) was held on February 23, 2005 at Japan Environment Association. After the discussion, the following decisions were made;

Decisions

- Primary assessment of 2 categories presented at the 33rd meeting of the EMCECC was conducted. As a result, none was subjected to secondary assessment. Also, "Dampening Solution and Appliance for Offset Printing" which had been given objection to the decision of deliberation at the 30th EMCECC was also not subjected to secondary assessment.
- It was decided that certification criteria for Eco Mark product category No.132 "Toner Cartridges Version1.0" is to be established on March 15, 2005.
- Partial revision of certification criteria for Eco Mark product category No.112 "Stationery/Office Supplies Version1.0" and No.131 "Civil Engineering Products Version1.0" that are submitted by Eco Mark Committee for Product Certification was approved and decided to be revised on February 23, 2005.
- Eco Mark product category No.117 "Copier" and No.122 "Printers" that are submitted by Eco Mark Committee for Product Certification was approved and decided to be revised on April 20, 2005.
- It was decided that draft certification criteria for Eco Mark product category No.118 "Plastic Products Version2.0 (draft)" is to be opened to public (scheduled to be established on September 1, 2005).
- Enlargement of scope of applicable products for "Digital Printers Version1.0" will be publicized. (Revision of Applicable Products will be made after "Digital Printers Version1.0" is established.)

Important Information

Postponement of Establishment of the Product Category No.117 "Copier Version2.0"

We postpone the date of establishment of Eco Mark Product Category No.117 Copiers Version2.0, although we have announced that the date of establishment was scheduled for March 1, 2005, after the deliberation reflecting those opinions given. The deliberation is still under way in Working Group. We, therefore, extend the validity date of current product category No.117 "Copier" until the date before the new certification criteria (Version2.0) is established.

Revision of Rco Mark Usage Fee

As we have announced in Eco Mark News No.51 (July 1, 2004), No.49 (April 20, 2004) and No.40 (April 20, 2003), we will revise the Eco Mark Usage Fee which will be linked to the annual sales of each company from the certification contracted after April 1, 2005. For individual contract, we will send the notification accordingly. Please follow the procedure described in it. (We have already sent the notification for some licensees.)

Information

Our Policy to Deal with "Reused Products"

We had meetings on "Reusable Products" as Eco Mark Product Category (the 1st: October 12, 2004, the 2nd: November 24, 2004). Based on the report of the meetings above and the 33rd Eco Mark Committee for Establishing Category and Criteria, we decided to consider further at a small committee on LCA technical evaluation (tentative) stipulating the definition of "reuse" at Eco Mark. (continued on the next page) Products and/or services including second hand products that have large potential in reducing the environmental burden by reusing them. Products, however, which have been already handled by the certain market mechanism, should be excluded. Following elements should be met;

- 1) Reuse products should have the equivalent function to that of brand-new products.
- 2) Products should be designed for reuse at the production stage.
- 3) The system for collection and reuse should be established. (At least, it is desirable that the system has been tested.)

"Repeatedly Usable Filtering Material for Protection against Dust" and "Reuse Pump Using Recycled Products" proposed as new product categories will be discussed at the small committee on LCA technical evaluation (tentative).
