Addition: Roofing Materials, Jacket Materials

3. No.138 "Building Products (Materials for Supplies) Version 1.1"

Addition: House Inlet

4. No.139 "Building Products (Equipment) Version1.0"

Addition: Bath Unit for Dwellings

5. No.142 "Ink Cartridges Version1.0"
